## Consent for Release of Information Form

Dutch-Willis Assessment Group-BIPP provides confidential communication between participants, staff and/or volunteers. Communications is defined as any written or spoken information shared between participants, staff and/or volunteers in the course of service delivery or in the relationship between the participant and the organization.

Victim/partner will be notified when you enter and exit the program and information on program and length and program requirements. Information disclosed by you during an assessment (intake), group sessions, and exit is confidential and will not be shared with victims.

The information that is exchanged is considered confidential and shall be kept as such by all staff and volunteers with the following exceptions:

- Your personal data will be submitted to TDCJ-CJAD by Dutch-Will Assessment Group-BIPP for the purposes of performing program assessments and other research.
- If there is probability of imminent physical injury to oneself or to others, staff will take safety initiatives and may, if appropriate, notify medical or law enforcement personnel and/or the victim and referral source.
- If your case records are subpoenaed.
- If your assessment or subsequent contact reveals the possibility of incidents of child abuse or neglect, or abuse of the elderly or disabled, it must be reported to the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services (TDFPS).
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By signing, I understand and agree to the conditions Dutch-Will Assessment Group-BIPP outlines above, and acknowledge that I have received a copy of this agreement.
